

SCSHA NOVICE CARD APPLICATION

In submitting this application for a SCSHA novice card I hereby affirm the information contained herein is true and correct and that I have not shown, trained a horse or judged a horse show either directly or indirectly for remuneration in the past three years. Premium money is excluded but reimbursements for expenses are not.

I also affirm that I, or my immediate family, own the horse I will show in novice. Other members of the immediate family may ride the novice person's horse, but the novice person must maintain probable training and care of the horse.

I understand that my status as a novice exhibitor may be subject to being revoked at any time if any of the rules and regulations are broken for novice classification.

EXPLANATION OF POINT REQUIREMENTS

Rule 84- If a Novice exhibitor earns 100 Novice points in a specific Novice division, the exhibitor must surrender his/her novice eligibility and may no longer show in the Novice classes of that division upon the conclusion of that season. The exhibitor may, however, continue to show in the novice classes of divisions for which they have not accrued 100 Novice points. When the exhibitor has earned 100 Novice points in each specified Novice Division, or has earned over 25 open, adult or youth performance points, being Division specific, (excluding walk-trot points), he/she must surrender the Novice Card at the end of that year. Novice points accrued prior to the 2011 show season will be applied to the appropriate division under this rule. The Points Sec. will determine eligibility according to points. Any other eligibility questions will be resolved by the Judges and Rules Committee.

Please remember to submit your \$5.00 novice card fee and your membership fee, if not already paid. (Fee is not refundable.)
